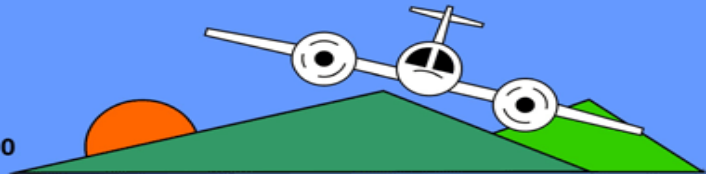

WWII Aircraft - WARBIRD Fly-In Armed Forces Day Saturday, May 17, 2008 11 AM - 3 PM

In grateful appreciation to the dedication, courage and sacrifice of the men and women who serve in this nation's military forces, Solberg Airport, will be celebrating Armed Forces Day with a WWII Aircraft "WARBIRD" Fly-In on Saturday, May 17th with a rain date of Sunday, May 18th from 11am to 3pm. 1940's dress code is optional but wear them if you've got them.

General Admission is \$5 per car and the gates open at 9:30 am. Witness with your own eyes a piece of our American aviation history. Hear the sounds of the radial engines and the supersonic propellers rotating. Take off in a WARBIRD...flights will be available (for different fees depending upon the length of the trip desired) in a North American Advanced Trainer AT-6. Or you can learn to fly yourself with an Introductory Flight Lesson in a Cessna. All flights will be booked and paid for on site the day of the event. Meet Jack Elliott former Star Ledger Newspaper columnist of "Wings Over New Jersey" and local author of "Adventures in Flying". Purchase a copy of this superb book on American aviation and have Jack Elliott personally sign it for you between the hours of 10am and 1pm.

Enter the "WARBIRD Infield Area" for \$5 per person (over the age of 12). Children under 12 accompanied by an adult are free. Walk up next to the flying machines that helped the United States win WWII. Learn more about these vintage aircraft from the owners/pilots. Meet World War II pilot Robert Vaucher who led the "Show of Force" when Japan signed the Instrument of Surrender on board the USS Missouri in the Pacific Ocean on September 2, 1945.
